Responsibilities:

- Schedule Special Music for worship by calling, e-mailing, and Face Booking members of the church! i.e. Have youth and adults use their instruments and voices during worship as solos, duets, etc. as offerings to God.
- Work with the Middle School and High School youth either 5:15-5:40 PM or 6:30-7:00 PM (Before worship) to help grow them in their love of worshipping God with music. (This would be a good time to make phone calls and invite members in to practice)
- Attend the worship and music committee meetings once each month on the fourth Thursday of each month. Bring ideas to incorporate into worship to these meetings. Hymns are reviewed at this meeting.
- Participate with the Youth Children's Worship service in helping Middle and High School youth have a part in the worship. (With Permission of the Board of Education and as Abilities Dictate: Write, lead, or even put together a musical Christmas Children's Worship service!)
- Compensation: \$15 per hour for about 6 hours each week during the school year (September – May). December hours may increase to 12 hours per week to incorporate Christmas rehearsals. Playing for services as abilities dictate at the \$40 rate per worship service. This rate can go up depending on ability. Organ lessons can be provided if desired. As time goes on Sunday service playing may become available.
- If applicant has the ability: play for worship services on half the Wednesday evenings on organ, piano, or use other talents and abilities. Otherwise, the music director will schedule organists/pianists so that all services have a qualified musician. The Music Director should plan to be present at Wednesday evening worship services and at least one Sunday morning service per month to help recruit musicians even if they are not playing or helping a youth use their gifts. The music director should have it as their goal to have groups and individuals sing or play at least once per month.
- Applicant has the ability, work with the Pastor of Calvary Lutheran Church and prospective choir members to set up rehearsal times for youth or adults as needed. The music director will direct such choirs. Work with musicians and other medium to accompany such (a) group(s). Calvary will work around the music director's schedule. The director will work around the schedule of the church!
